Details of IP:	Kenneth Pattullo of Glasgow, an Insolvency Practitioners Association (IPA) member and Licensed Insolvency Practitioner.
Summary of complaint:	This Order is made in relation to a complaint that Mr Pattullo breached the fundamental principle of professional Competence and Due Care of the Insolvency Code of Ethics by failing to effectively manage and control cases held in Belfast. Mr Pattullo was found liable to disciplinary action under the IPA's Articles of Association.
Summary of sanctions:	The Common Sanctions Guidance provides for a starting point of £5,000 for a serious breach of the Fundamental Principle of Professional Competence and Due Care. No mitigating factors were identified but the following were considered as aggravating: • The high number of cases affected and the fact that the issues identified affected so many different aspects of an Insolvency Practitioner's role. • A general lack of supervision identified on Mr Pattullo's cases for 18 months. • Mr Pattullo's significant adverse disciplinary and regulatory history (four sanctions in five years). • The repetition of issues. The Committee imposed a disciplinary order that Mr Pattullo be Severely Reprimanded and fined £15,000.
